Listen to God! Acts 11:19-21



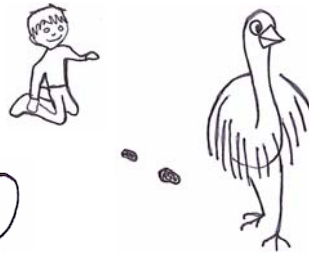
After his resurrection, and before he returned to heaven, Jesus told his followers to spread the good news about him to people everywhere. The verses you read tell how this was happening.
