"They look so graceful," Vicki said as she watched the swans peacefully gliding through the water on the inlet. But if we could see under the water, we would see little feet paddling like mad.

Some people are a bit like that. They look happy. They have the coolest clothes and all the latest stuff. We may wish we were like them. But we don't always know what other people are really like underneath the surface that we can see. They may be lonely, or sad, or worried about something, or think no one likes them.
